LOCAL MAN RECEIVES INTERNATIONAL AWARD



John Alldis, Assistant Secretary of the Sussex Inlet RSL Sub-Branch recently returned from London with his wife Sue where John attended two Air Safety conferences. They later attended a gala dinner provided by the Association of Licensed Aircraft Engineers [UK] and Aircraft Engineers International on a cruise boat on the Thames.

Aircraft Engineers International took advantage of the occasion to present John with Honorary Life Membership of AEI for his life long contribution to Air Safety. As a former Federal President of the Australian Licensed Aircraft Engineers Association, John was the founder of AEI and it is now headquartered in Holland with affiliates in 60 countries.
